

Information about “New Light” by Leighton Scott

“New Light” is one of the unique surfaces Leighton has created using a base of Z-Ment adhesive and adding other materials. In this case, acrylic paint was mixed with the white adhesive base, and imitation coal used in model railroading and glitter were added before everything dried. The reflected light pattern is different and complex.

The question might be asked, “Where is this new type of light coming from?”

Leighton is the first known artist to use adhesive mortar as an art medium and has been creating unique surfaces since 1979. Two other sister “New Light” paintings have been sold, one to a New Jersey eBay buyer, and one to a Maryland resident at a charity auction in Marriottsville, Maryland.
